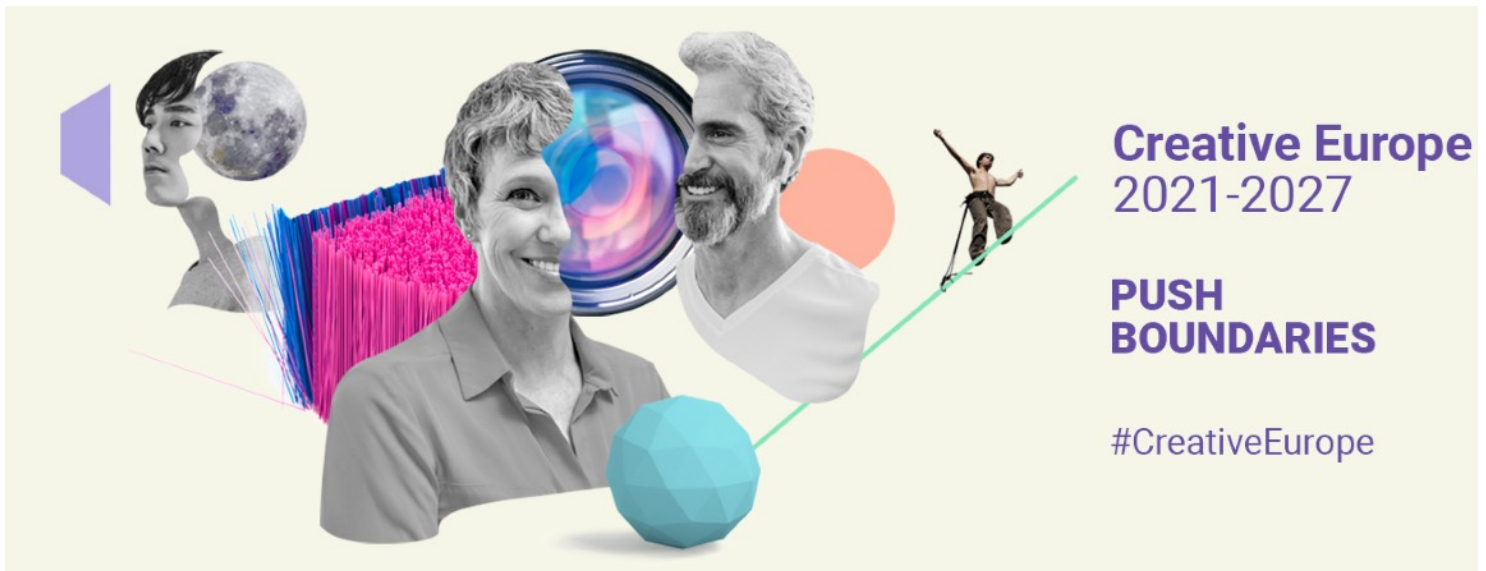

International Twin City Tourfilm Festival – Georgia & Spain

This newsletter focuses on the International Twin City Tourfilm Festival, a CARAVANE activity that uses audiovisual storytelling to connect cultural actors and audiences in Georgia and Spain.

Through film and discussion, the festival explores how cities and environments are represented and experienced across different contexts.

International Twin City Tourfilm Festival – Georgia & Spain

The festival links activities in Georgia and Spain, creating a shared platform for screenings, discussions, and exchange. Filmmakers, cultural professionals, and audiences engage with audiovisual works that explore tourism, urban identity, and environmental themes.

Screenings provide insights into how cities and landscapes are portrayed through film, highlighting the relationship between place, narrative, and perception. Discussions following the screenings encourage dialogue between creators and audiences, allowing for reflection on shared challenges and differing perspectives.

By linking twin cities, the festival strengthens transnational cooperation and highlights common concerns related to sustainability and representation. The audiovisual format allows complex themes to be communicated in accessible and engaging ways.

The Twin City Tourfilm Festival reinforces CARAVANE's emphasis on cross-border dialogue and cultural exchange. Through film, it contributes to shared reflection on how cities, environments, and identities are narrated and understood.
