Throughout all CARAVANE laboratories, one core principle remains constant: connection comes before production. Participants do not simply take part in workshops; they become part of a shared journey shaped by travel, encounters, and time spent together. Moving between places, sharing meals, rehearsing, exchanging ideas informally, and creating collectively are all integral to the experience and are just as important as the artistic outcomes themselves.

These shared moments foster an environment of mutual respect, emotional safety, and openness. Within this supportive setting, participants feel encouraged to express their ideas freely, take creative risks, and experiment without fear of failure. Trust develops naturally, allowing collaboration to grow organically while strengthening both individual confidence and collective creativity.

For many participants, CARAVANE offers their first international artistic encounter, bringing them together with peers from different countries, cultures, and social backgrounds. For those with limited access to cultural platforms, this experience is particularly meaningful, providing a strong sense of recognition and belonging. These encounters lay the foundations for equitable collaboration and shared ownership of the creative process, reinforcing CARAVANE's commitment to inclusion, co-creation, and mutual respect.
